Nick Tyndall died on Wednesday 19th April. He was a morris dancer with Icknield Way Morris Men for more than ten years, Squire from 1998 to 2000, and remained a member of the Travelling Morris from his Cambridge days. He was also a singer of many fine English and Irish folk songs. He worked hard to encourage many youngsters into the morris and was a passionate supporter of English traditional dancing. He also worked tirelessly for charities particularly the salt miners in India.

A concert (originally instigated by Nick) is to take place to celebrate Nick's support for English tradition in All Saints Church Faringdon on Saturday May 13th. The concert, based on the life of Thomas Hardy, features readings from Hardy and music & songs from the Hardy family manuscripts. The narration is by Tom Taylor, music by the Mad Hatters Ceilidh Band with songs from Sharon Salwowski.

It starts at 7:30 pm and tickets are at £7:50 (Concessions £5:00) with proceeds going to Christian Aid (one Nick's many charities).
